**RIGHT PRIORITIES** – Philippians 3:13 "..but one thing I do, forgetting what is behind and reaching forward to what is ahead..."

As we enter a New Year, what could you do or change that if you did would make a tremendous difference in your life and possibly make the world a better place?

I suggest three things.

1. **God First** –What would happen in your life if you put God first in all things? In your marriage and family, your church, your work, your personal decisions...
