A Word from the Transitional Pastor, Dr. Dan Garland

November is the month when we focus on being Thankful. This is a time to count our blessings and give thanks to God for the blessings of life. It's not hard for us to count our blessings, is it? Most of us could quickly and easily jot down a rather lengthy list, including thanks for family, for friends, for food, for clothing, for cars, for a home, for health, for freedom, for our church, for opportunities to serve, and so on.

Psalm 100 teaches us how and why to be thankful. In the Psalm we are encouraged to give thanks for who God is and what He has done for us as the ground and cause of our thanksgiving. This Psalm teaches us why and how to give thanks.

100:1 – Shout joyfully to the Lord, all the earth, the KJV says, *Make a joyful noise unto the Lord* – this is all about how to worship, how to express our gratitude, how to be thankful and live thankful lives all year long not just one week out of the year.

The call to thankful living and giving thanks begins with focusing on who God is, on the invisible God who has made Himself visible in Jesus Christ and His Cross and Resurrection. We are not called to give thanks for stuff like, cars, computers and iPads. Why? Because these things are temporary and fleeting. We are called and instructed in how to express our thankfulness to God and that is in our worship, both personal and corporate.

How are we to do this? What should giving thanks look like? Psalm 100 is our guide.

Know that the Lord Himself is God - We shout to the Lord because we acknowledge He is God all by Himself. Who He is and what He has done warrants our praise and those who come to know Him through His Son Jesus Christ are to praise Him for His goodness, grace and mercy.

He made us - He is our Creator - He is the Maker of heaven and earth. Genesis 1:1 - In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth. It is our confession of worship that life begins with God. We are to worship Him as Creator and sustainer of life.

We did not create ourselves – However, when we acknowledge that God is our Creator then the next step is what does He expect of me? When we say we are thankful for the blessings of life, thankful to whom? To Mother Nature, to fate, to luck, to evolution, to reincarnation? The Psalm calls upon us to acknowledge that God is God and nothing else and no one else is. That is the beginning of being thankful.

We are His people and the sheep of His pasture – submission, reverence, relationship – we can know God because He knows us and has chosen to love us with the love of Christ.

This acknowledgement is the basis of our thanksgiving and is expressed in our joyful worship. We are to enter into His gates with thanksgiving and His courts with Praise. Worship with thanksgiving and praise is expressed in the phrase "give thanks." It is Hebrew word that means the extended hand, to raised hand, the open hand.

1 Thess. 5:18, "Give thanks in all circumstances, for this is God's will for you in Christ Jesus."

This is probably one of the hardest things to dopraise God in the midst of the difficulty. We might think, "I could be more thankful if things would go right in my life once in a while".

The thankful person realizes that things could be worse. They don't forget that God is still good even though life might stink right now. The thankful person knows that God is good all the time, His love and faithfulness endure forever.

I am thankful for the grace and mercy of God in Christ I am experiencing as I follow Jesus and His Way of living. I am thankful for His claim and call on my life. I am thankful for my family and friends. I am thankful for the measure of health I have been afforded. I am thankful to be able to serve the Lord at Horse Cave Baptist Church as we work and pray together to prepare for the Pastor God has coming.

Please take time this month to count your blessings and to express your thankfulness to God and those close to you.
