A Word from the Transitional Pastor, Dr. Dan Garland

Update of the Transitional Process:

The first step in the process was to assemble a Transition Team who would help guide the process of taking a close look at Horse Cave community and the church itself. The twenty folks who agreed to serve have been meeting monthly since October and will conclude their work in early March.

We have examined four major areas of the church:

- Administration how is the church organized to carry out our mission?
- Facilities how do the building and grounds support and facilitate our mission?
- Ministries how are we carrying out our Mission of the Church?
- Worship/Outreach How are we impacting the community and beyond?

Reorganized Church Council.

One of the needs discovered is that of a functioning Church Council. Even though there is a Church Council provided for in the By-Laws it does not function. Therefore, the Transition Team is recommending a reorganization of the Church Council to be more strategic and functional. This recommendation will be discussed during the Sunday School time on Sunday morning, February 11 from 10 – 10:30 AM in the worship center. All youth and adults are encouraged to attend this overview.

As we bring the preliminary work of the Transition Team to an end, it is time for the church to select from among the faithful members a Pastor Search Committee.
