Liberty Association of Baptist

Is our association still active? What do they do? What are their funds used for? These are questions we hear and hope to help answer them. LAB is very active. You can read about all the activities through their newsletter, "Liberty Lights," which is available in our main lobby each month. The funds they receive are used as listed below.



The money received comes back to the churches in these areas:

1. Some is used to pay Bro. Lynn Traylor's salary as your Association servant.
2. Some is budgeted to the three teams which carry out the work of the Association:

Church Strengthening Team: this team will provide assistance to strengthen and revitalize churches with their specific needs. The CST offers help and resources to churches, pastors and church leaders to strengthen the work of the church. Books, training resources and scholarships to attend conferences have been some of the ways this team has worked.

Evangelism and Missions Team: this team will work to assist the churches in fulfilling the Great Commission and to be an Acts 1:8 church. This team has provided churches with prospect lists and maps of their church field, has provided evangelism tools and training, and also provides money to assist persons/churches sending people on mission trips.

Leadership Development Team: this team will assist churches to develop and equip leaders for Kingdom work. Ways this team has worked include: providing scholarship money for pastors and leaders to attend training conferences, money to help attend the Association Seminary Extension class, and providing books and other resources for church leaders and pastors.

3. Money from the Association also supports the ministries of: Camp Joy, Crossroads Life Center, Glasgow Christian Academy, and Next Step. All of these teams serve our churches and are eager to help Pastors and Church Leaders.

Crossroads Life Center with offices in Glasgow, KY and Munfordville, KY offer FREE pregnancy testing, parenting classes & material help for families, including diapers, wipes, formula, baby food, baby and maternity clothes.
